Led by certified teachers, these classes include activities like grammar exercises, vocabulary building, speaking practice, and real conversations with native speakers, offering direct feedback and addressing common challenges faced by learners.

Thematic Community Classes with Teachers



Thematic Community Class in KOGO Study Group is a supplementary class, which will be held LIVE via Zoom and focus on group discussions led by certified and professional teachers. These thematic classes, which include Grammar Exercises, Vocabulary Improvement, Speaking Practice, Cultural Class and Live Conversations with Native Teachers, are designed to enhance students' Korean language skills.

It's important to note that the thematic classes in the KOGO Study Group <u>are not</u> <u>standalone</u>. Our academic team has formulated these classes into a comprehensive supplementary curriculum to fill the gaps not covered in detail and provide a deeper understanding beyond the contents offered in the main courses. Therefore, this <u>program does not eliminate the need to take the main classes.</u>

Practicing in thematic classes is designed to address common challenges faced by Korean language learners, with topics of interest such as:

- Common mistakes in Korean grammar usage
- Group challenge with teacher's accompaniment
- Group discussion and presentation
- In-depth discussions on specific topics with related vocabulary and expressions
- Real Korean conversations on particular topics, along with direct practice
- Get to know Korean culture and real situation
- TOPIK questions discussions, and much more.

Class Recording Access



Students in the study group **will have the access** to some community class / info sessions recordings **for up to two weeks** after they are uploaded (viewable online, no download option), while <u>practice and conversation classes will not be recorded</u>.

Online Q&A Platform



For an additional support, the students will have access in our website where the students can ask questions and get answers from KOGO teacher in charge. This feature ensures that learning continues outside of the class, and that students can clarify doubts as they progress through their learning journey.

Every week, our team will post a O&A thread where students can ask questions and help each other. The teacher in charge will respond to the questions and discussions happened in the thread. **Students can also ask questions privately through the website chat**, and our teacher will respond within the week.

Study Group Access


KOGO study group access will open one week before the start of the month, along with the detailed schedule. Options include a monthly package, a 4-month package, and a package for the remainder of the year.

KOGO Studio courses focus on building strong foundations for our students, while community classes in the KOGO Study Group are designed to maintain and expand students' knowledge. We recommend combining both the courses and the Study Group for the best result. Please contact our Customer Service if you need any help or further assistance.

What's the difference between KOGO's TOPIK I Preparation Class with community class in KOGO study group?

Our original TOPIK I Practice Class is an intimate and in-depth preparation course for TOPIK I, while the TOPIK I community classes in the KOGO Study Group are one-hour sessions focused on solving TOPIK I practice problems.

Do you still have free events after this?

<u>Yes</u>, we will continue to offer some of our community programs as free public events <u>at least once a month</u>. However, recording access will only be available to community members.

Can I join this Study Group even though I am currently doing a self-study / studying in other place?

Sure! Everyone who is learning Korean Language in Beginner Stage (KOGO Level 1~3) is welcomed to join. Check your level for free HERE.

Is this study group a safe place to new Korean Language learners?

Yes, it is. However, we always recommend that you learn and practice related grammars, vocabularies, and expressions before joining our community class to get the most out of your learning experience.

Why can't we access the recording for practice & conversation classes?

Our practice and conversation classes are <u>designed to be fully interactive</u>, encouraging active participation between students and the teacher. It encourages the students to engage and actively practice during the class, rather than passively watching through video recordings.

How many students will be in one community class?

We will accept <u>up to 95-98 students</u> in one class, and currently, our study group is open to a maximum of 100 students. Any changes to this limit will be communicated accordingly.

How to maximize the use of KOGO Study group?

We recommend <u>preparing the related study materials</u> before joining any classes and <u>actively participating</u> in all class activities.



Frequently Asked Questions

Can I send my questions to the teachers 24/7?

Yes, but the teacher may <u>not be able to respond in real-time</u>. We assure you that every student in the KOGO Study Group will receive an answer, but please expect a delay in replies. The Q&A section will be open every week on the community page, and all members can also ask questions privately through the website chat box.

Can I use my account together with my friends?

No, it is prohibited and against our rules to share one account with multiple people. If we discover such activity, immediate expulsion and banning from the study group community will occur.

Is it refundable?

No, all access packages are non-refundable for any reason.
